- Hidden away in some of the most remote areas of southwest China, the A Che people are known to few outsiders. As a result, they are completely unreached and unevangelized.
- The A Che people are polytheists, worshipping many gods. In the past, they claim they were closer to the gods, but then their line of communication with the Creator was broken. Therefore, they now believe they are no longer able to enter heaven.
- They celebrate two important festivals:
 - *The Open Street Festival is held every eighth day of the first lunar month in Damaidi District.
 - *The Dragon Worship Festival is held on the second day of the second lunar month in the Fadian Community of Yulong District.
