- The Moroccan Arab people live mainly in the north and west portions of Morocco, however, they prefer living in the more fertile regions near the Mediterranean Sea. The Moroccan Arab people make up less than half of the country's population.
- Arab society is both patriarchal (male-dominated) and patrilineal, which means that the male lineage is given more honor and all inheritances are passed down through the males.
- Life for the Moroccan Arab people centers on important ceremonies, such as birth, marriage, and death. The most elaborate of all ceremonies is the wedding.
- Virtually all of the Moroccan Arab people in this region

are Muslim. They adhere to the Koran and observe the five basic pillars of Islam.
