## MAGUZAWA OF NORTH AFRICA

### STATISTICS

Population 189,000

Main Language - Hausa

The Maguzawas are a Hausa tribe located in northern Nigeria. The community is ruled by "sarki", or leaders, who are the head of several important areas of Maguzawa life: the head of farming, the head of the pagans & the head of the bush.

Though heavily influenced by Islam, they hold to their pre-Islamic practices. They believe in some 3,000 spirits called "iskoki." They pour wine & animal blood over stone altars, invoking these spirits & the spirits of their ancestors, to protect them & to prosper their harvests.

Alcohol known as "burukutu" is consumed heavily & used in all their ceremonies. The rate of alcoholism is very high.
